Updates to neonatal, pediatric resuscitation guidelines based on new evidence. Resuscitation and life support guidelines for neonatal and pediatric patients have been updated to reflect the latest evidence to improve care. Pediatric Basic and Advanced Life Support and Neonatal Resuscitation are parts 4 and 5 of the 2020 American Heart Association Guidelines for Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Emergency Cardiovascular Care released Oct. 21 and published in Pediatrics (see resources).

### Welcome to NRP

– The 2017 NRP guidelines recommend a 30- to 60-second delay in clamping in all term and preterm infants not requiring resuscitation. – If the placental circulation is disrupted (e.g., placental abruption), the cord should be clamped immediately. Investigators found that delayed clamping reduced mortality before discharge.

### Recent Recommendations in Neonatal Resuscitation 2019 UPDATE

### Highlights of the New Neonatal Resuscitation Program ...

2017 NRP Major Changes Cord Clamping: evidence suggests that cord clamping should be delayed for at least 30 to 60 seconds for most vigorous term and preterm newborns. □Insufficient evidence for recommendation for infants who require resuscitation or who have known risk factors for decreased placental circulation. (Class IIa, LOE C-LD)

### To Suction or Not to Suction

The NRP has produced a document summarizing the changes in the guidelines. Some of the changes in recommendations for neonatal resuscitation include: non-vigorous newborns with meconium-stained fluid do not require routine intubation and tracheal suctioning

### New Neonatal Resuscitation Guidelines Released

Even in a healthy newborn, plasma glucose concentration will fall during the first two hours after delivery, usually to a value as low as (but usually not below) 40 mg/dL (2.2 mmol/L). Within 4 to 6 hours of birth, blood glucose should stabilize between 45 and 80 mg/dL (2.5 and 4.4 mmol/L) ( Cornblath et al., 2000 ).

### WHO | Guidelines on basic newborn resuscitation

Revisions include: • Begin the resuscitation with antenatal counseling (when appropriate) and a team briefing and equipment check. • Maintain the newborn’s normal body temperature during resuscitation. • Consider using a cardiac monitor when PPV begins. • Ensure ventilation that inflates and moves the chest.
